1. **Sub for SB 23** retains education cuts at half of the non-education agencies for FY 2009.

2. During the debate on the omnibus appropriations bill, **HB 2373**, Sen. Ty Masterson, R-Andover, made a motion to increase education budget cuts from 2.75 percent to 3.75 percent.

6. During the debate on the omnibus appropriations bill, **H Sub for SB 22**, Rep. Knox, R-Altoona, made a motion to repeal the in-state tuition status given to undocumented residents who met a prescribed set of requirements. *KASB opposed the amendment.* May 1, 2009 HJ 689
